



The North London Aspire Development Partnership (DP) develops and delivers innovative services to support asylum seekers in the North London Boroughs of Barnet, Enfield, Haringey, and Waltham Forest. The project is funded by the EQUAL stream of the European Social Fund (ESF).

The North London Aspire DP is diverse in its make-up, and includes organisations that have a long history of working with some of the most excluded communities in London.

The partnership hopes to leave a legacy of best practice through influencing local, regional, and national policy makers through demonstrating the success of pilot projects and services.

The aims of the North London Aspire DP are to:

- Develop new services to address the negative impact of the asylum-seeking process upon peoples' lives
- Empower asylum seekers to contribute to their host communities
- Reduce the negative effects of the asylum process regardless of whether an individual's application is successful or not.

In addition to the DPs' official partners, the DP also co-ordinates with Haringey Teaching PCT, The Bridge-Seven Sisters NDC, the International Organisation for Migration (IOM), and Haringey Asylum Team.

- Haringey Council
- London North Learning Skills Council
- North London Partnership Consortium Limited
- Positive Care Link.

The North London Aspire will be DP be recruiting further associates and partners in order enhance its services. The DP is keen to cultivate links with other organisations that support refugees, asylum seekers, and those living with HIV+/AIDS.
